Fall Leaf Pick-Up – Saturday, November 1, 2025

ELIA is once again offering fall leaf pick-up to help protect our lake from excess phosphorus and weed growth.

- Date: Saturday, November 1, 2025
- Time: Place leaf bags at the end of your driveway by 8:00 AM
- What to Bag: LEAVES ONLY no grass clippings, brush, flowerpots, soil, or garbage. Bag leaves when they are dry to keep them light


July 4th Boat Parade –
